## EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 243 622

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
<b>Tanker/Vehicle Accident</b>	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. <b>Call the emergency services: Dial 111</b>
<b>Spill or leak</b>	Keep all bystanders away. Wear long sleeved shirt, long pants, waterproof gloves and safety goggles or face shield. Do not eat, drink or smoke when using. Wash hands and face before meals and after work. Absorb spilled material with absorbent material such as sand clay or cat litter. Keep out animals and unprotected persons. Transfer waste into an approved drum. To decontaminate spill area, tools and equipment, wash with a suitable solution (i.e. organic solvent, detergent, bleach or caustic) and add the solution to the drums of wastes already collected. Dispose of contaminated wastes in accordance with the requirements of Local Authorities.
<b>Fire</b>	<b>Call the Fire Service: Dial 111.</b> Isolate fire area. Evacuate downwind. Wear full protective clothing and self-contained breathing apparatus. Do not breathe or contact smoke, gases or vapors generated.

## FIRST AID

<b>If Swallowed</b>	DO NOT induce vomiting. <b>For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or Seek medical attention.</b> Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
<b>If in Eyes</b>	Hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.
<b>If on Skin</b>	Take off contaminated clothing. Wash skin with plenty of soap and water. Do not scrub skin. If skin irritation occurs: Get medical advice/ attention.
<b>If Inhaled</b>	Remove patient to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-nose. Get medical attention if symptoms develop.

## STORAGE AND SEGREGATION SUMMARY

**Storage:** Store locked up in corrosive resistant container with a resistant inner liner. Do not mix or store in containers or systems made of aluminium or having aluminium fittings. Store in original container, tightly closed in a dry, cool and well ventilated place away from feed, seeds and foodstuffs. Keep away from sparks and flames.

**Aggregate Storage Volume Thresholds:** When stored with substances of the same hazard the aggregate quantity must be considered. For full details refer to the current NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals and the HSNO Regulations.
