EMERGENCY PROCEDURES 24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 243 622 IF THIS HAPPENS DO THIS Tanker/Vehicle Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Accident Call the emergency services: Dial 111 Spill or leak Keep all bystanders away. Wear goggles, respirator, chemical resistant clothing (buttoned to neck and wrist), gloves and boots. Absorb spills with inert material and place in waste containers. Wash area with water and absorb with further inert material. Dispose of contained wastes in accordance with the requirements of Local Authorities. Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Isolate fire area. Evacuate downwind. Wear full protective clothing and self-contained Fire breathing apparatus. Do not breathe or contact smoke, gases or vapors generated. **FIRST AID** If Swallowed DO NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If in Eyes Hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention. If on Skin Take off contaminated clothing. Wash skin with plenty of soap and water. Do not scrub skin. Call a Poison Centre or doctor for treatment advice if irritation develops. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If Inhaled Remove patient to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-nose. Get medical attention if

Storage: Store locked up in original packaging. Keep away from direct sunlight. Keep tightly closed in a dry, cool and well ventilated place.
