# READ LABEL COMPLETELY BEFORE USE GENERAL INFORMATION Curriew is a contact and systemic fungicide that has curative activity on downy mildew and late blight, when applied



Harmful if swallowed. Causes serious eye irritation. May cause an allergic skin reaction. May cause damage to organs through prolonged or repeated exposure

#### **ECOTOXICITY**

Toxic to aquatic life with long lasting effects. Avoid contamination of any water supply with product or empty container. Do not apply onto or into water. Harmful to terrestrial vertebrates. Avoid release to the environment. Collect spillage

#### HANDLING PRECAUTIONS – FOR WORKPLACE USE ONLY

Personal Protection: Do not handle until all safety precautions have been read and understood. Do not breathe mist or spray. Do not eat, drink or smoke when using this product. When mixing or applying, avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wear full protective clothing, gloves and goggles. Wash hands and face before meals and after work. Wash protective clothing after work. Contaminated work clothing should not be allowed out of the workplace. Equipment: Apply using accurately calibrated and maintained equipment in accordance with the New Zealand andard for the Management of Agrichemicals (NZS8409). Flush spray equipment thoroughly with water after use. Storage: Store in original container tightly closed and in a locked, dry cool, well ventilated area away from fertilisers, feed, seeds and foodstuffs. Keep out of reach of children. Store in accordance with NZ 8409 Management of Agrichemicals. Emergency response plans are required where 1000 Kgs or more of this product are stored. Shelf Life: When stored appropriately this product should show no significant degradation for two years from the date of manufacture.

Spillage: Move non-essential people from the area. Wear appropriate protective clothing and prevent material from entering waterways. Absorb spills with inert material and place in waste containers. Sweep up solids without creating dust. Wash area with water and absorb with further inert material. Dispose of waste safely (such as to a suitable landfill).

#### FIRST AID

#### IMPORTANT - RESISTANCE MANAGEMENT

Curfew contains the GROUP 27 FUNGICIDE cymoxanil. Resistance to pesticides can develop from excessive use. To minimise this risk, avoid using this fungicide exclusively all season, avoid unnecessary spraying and endeavour to alternate with fungicides from other groups within the crop and in subsequent seasons for a sprayed paddock. Use strictly in accordance with label instructions. Maintain good cultural practices. Always apply Curfew in mixture with mancozeb fungicide. See 'Directions for Use' for recommendations. Do not use Curfew more than three times in succession and do not apply more than 5 times per season.

#### RAINFALL

Do not spray if rainfall is expected within 1 hour of spraying.

### COMPATIBILITY

Curfew is compatible with most insecticides, but it is not compatible with Bordeaux mixture, lime-sulphur or other alkaline nraducts

Add the required amount of Curfew directly into the partly filled spray tank whilst agitating. Ensure Curfew is mixed thoroughly before adding any other pesticide to the spray tank. Agitate during use and before using after a stoppage. Use all spray as soon as possible after mixing and do not allow to stand for an extended period, such as overnight.

#### SPRAY DRIFT

Take all reasonable steps to ensure that Curfew does not cause any significant adverse effects to the environment beyond the application area.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

## It is an offence to use this product on animals

As indicated below. Curfew must be used in combination with mancozeb, and is intended to be used as part of a spray programme with alternative fungicides.

CROP	DISEASE	CRITICAL COMMENTS
Garlic Onions	Downy Mildew	Apply 250-350g/ha as a tankmix partner with mancozeb at the recommended label rates. Begin spraying at the 2 true leaf stage and continue at 7-10 day intervals. Apply Curfew immediately after an infection period (but before disease symptoms occur). Do not use more than three times in succession and do not apply more than 5 times per season.
Potatoes	Late Blight	Apply 220:250/ph as a tanknix partner with menoceab at the recommended label rates at 7:10 day immoreds. Use Curtev, applying immediately after an infection period (flux before disease symptoms occur) and use alternative fungicides at other times. Do not use more than three times in succession and do not apply more than 5 times per season. Use the higher rate of Curfew under extreme infection conditions (Warm with high humidity).

It is an offence for users of this product to cause residues exceeding the relevant MRL in the Food Notice: Maximum Residue Levels for Agricultural Compounds.
